Cureus and Libento celebrate topping-out ceremony for Senior Residence Alfter with 95 care places

- Looking back at the topping-out ceremony held on 16 November 2022
- Senior residence with 95 care places for full inpatient care including short-term care as well as 8 staff flats will be built
- Public restaurant, laundry, hairdresser, and fireplace lounge in the complex
- Completion and first use of the building in sustainable KfW Effizienzhaus 40 standard planned for summer 2023

Hamburg/Winsen (Aller)/Alfter, 17. November 2022. Cureus, an integrated property company that specialises in developing and actively managing its own inpatient care home portfolio, and Libento as the future operator of Senior Residence Alfter yesterday invited to the topping-out ceremony. The approximately 45 guests featured planners, craftsmen, neighbours and representatives from politics, administration and the community, including Dr. Rolf Schumacher, Mayor of Alfter and Local Chairman Norbert Lehna. The traditional ceremony featured a topping-out wreath, speeches, and the hammering in of the final nail into the roof structure. The visitors enjoyed food and drink after the ceremony and were keen to find out more about the new senior residence on a walk around the construction site and through the shell of the building. The construction site is located in the currently emerging residential quarter Bahnhofstraße in 53347 Alfter and the general contractor is Zenz Massivhaus GmbH located in Cochem.

"Our project is progressing as planned," says Sebastian Warz, the responsible project manager at Cureus: "With the completion of the roof and the installation of the windows before winter, we can now also start the interior work regardless of the weather. In the context of this topping-out ceremony, we would like to express our traditional thanks to all those involved in the construction for their work so far. I am optimistic that we will be able to hand over to our proven, professional operating partner Libento in summer 2023."

"We, too, would like to thank the teams involved in the construction and are already very much looking forward to this new location, the future appearance of which can already be seen in the current state of construction," says Andrea Willigerod, Managing Director of Libento

Staff recruitment is already in full swing and the first residents have already expressed their interest."

The complex will create a total of around 80 new and crisis-proof jobs in nursing, social care, administration, building services and housekeeping in the kitchen, laundry and cleaning departments.

The first Libento Seniorenresidenzen facility was opened in Wuppertal in autumn 2021. The opening of the senior residence in Heimerzheim will follow in spring 2023. The senior residence in Alfter is scheduled to open in early summer. With the Solingen location, Libento will open its fourth location in late summer.

About Libento Senior Residence Alfter

An ultra-modern care facility is being built on an area of 3,700 square metres, which will meet the increasing demand for care places in Alfter with contemporary forms of living once it is completed. The modern senior residence comprises 95 places for inpatient care, and eight places for short-term care; there will also be eight staff bedrooms on the premisses. The residence is constructed in accordance with the energetically optimised Effizienzhaus 40 standard of KfW, whereby the environmentally sound heating is provided by a combined heat and power plant (CHP), which simultaneously generates electricity. The facade with the linear and modern design will be an eye-catching architectural feature and will blend harmoniously into the surrounding housing development with its colour scheme.

Giving care the space it needs

Many people are aware of the shortage of nursing staff and are actively implementing appropriate measures to solve the shortage, but there is little awareness of the undersupply of nursing homes. According to a recent study by bulwiengesa (<u>found here</u>), up to 600,000 new care places need to be built across Germany by 2040, but construction is lagging behind. Cureus is constantly on the lookout for new plots of land to implement its proprietary system approach and accelerate the construction of modern care facilities.
