# Multi-generation quarter Seevetal-Fleestedt – project presentation & construction site ceremony by Cureus and MEDIKO

Hamburg/Hanover/Seevetal, 21 July 2021. Cureus GmbH as the owner and MEDIKO as the future operator of the Generationsquartier Seevetal presented the neighbourhood development currently under construction and its future use in more detail at a large construction site event yesterday. Around 100 guests accepted the invitation, including craftspeople, neighbours, project participants and representatives from politics and the community. Visitors enjoyed delicious food and drink and were very interested to learn more about the new Generationsquartier Seevetal-Fleestedt, which is currently under construction, as well as the care places, apartments and day care centres that will be available in the future.

"As we were unable to celebrate either the laying of the foundation stone or the topping-out ceremony for this modern new urban quarter in Seevetal due to the pandemic, we wanted to use the summer to provide information about the project on site and, of course, to thank everyone involved in the construction for their very good work so far", says Rainer Schmitz, Project Manager at Cureus, which is building the quarter and will include it in its real estate portfolio after completion. "We are now entering the final spurt and plan to complete the project in the late autumn of this year so that our long-standing operating partner MEDIKO can start operations at the beginning of 2022", Schmitz adds.

"Bringing generations together, learning from each other and being there for and with each other – that is what everyday life should be like in the Generationsquartier Seevetal", emphasises Christian Cohausz, Managing Director of MEDIKO. "We are looking forward to an exciting mix of life with the day care centre in the building and are sure that the residents of the senior residence, the guests of the outpatient daycare centre as well as the tenants of the assisted living units will benefit greatly from this and will certainly be able to offer one or two things for our little neighbours to share with the adults".

Senior residence, outpatient daycare, assisted living units and day care centre "under one roof"

On the approx. 14,500-square-metre site at Winsener Landstraße 12 in 21217 Seevetal-Fleestedt, three buildings have been under construction since summer 2020 in accordance with the modern and environmentally friendly KfW 40 standard. They are connected by a





common and generously designed garden with lots of green space, which, in addition to a playground for the daycare centre, also includes a soccer field, exercise areas and meeting, rest and relaxation zones. The complex includes 69 car parking spaces, nine of which are handicapped accessible, as well as 16 bicycle parking spaces. Seevetal is located on the southern border of Hamburg and has excellent transport connections. The accessibility of the Generationsquartier for residents, visitors and employees is excellent. In the immediate vicinity, shopping facilities, doctors, social and leisure venues as well as public transport are within easy walking distance.

With 116 modern single rooms for inpatient care, the day care centre and four residential units on the ground floor, the residence building in the middle of the site is the heart of the Generation Quarter. It has about 6,900 square metres of gross floor area (GFA) and houses the day care centre with two groups and direct access to the garden, playground and a public restaurant with fresh cuisine and sun terrace, a hairdresser and an in-house laundry on the ground floor. The modern, friendly ambience in the foyer with reception has a hotel character. The two floors above and a staggered floor contain 116 generously designed, barrier-free single rooms, 55 of which are wheelchair-accessible. Each room has its own bathroom and can be individually furnished to create a feel-good atmosphere and a private retreat. The residence is divided into five residential groups, each with its own lounge area and kitchen, to create a familiar, homelike atmosphere for the residents. The four assisted living units on the ground floor are each about 50 square metres in size and, in addition to a living room with cooking facilities and a bedroom, also have a bathroom, hallway and storage room.

To the east of the residence with the day care centre for children, there are two further three-storey residential buildings on the site along Winsener Landstraße. They house on an area of around 365 square metres on the ground floor an outpatient daycare centre for 20 guests with recreation rooms, bathrooms and terraces and 35 barrier-free assisted living units. These comprise one or two rooms and are each between 41 and 54 square metres in size. Some of the units are wheelchair-accessible; in addition to a bedroom and a private bathroom, all units have a living room with a kitchenette, a hallway, storage space and a balcony.

### Living, residing, working - there are still places and apartments available

The allocation of the day care places is done by the municipality of Seevetal, the operator is the DRK.

Each complex's architecture and facade incorporate individual touches and are constructed to the highest quality standards, integrating seamlessly into their surroundings. Th Cureus system approach also prioritises sustainability, both in terms of a care home's long-term economic viability and its impact on the environment. All Cureus care homes are, for example, constructed in accordance with the KfW 40 energy-efficiency standard, while the bulk procurement of floor coverings or elevator systems, for example, ensures cost synergies and long-term maintenance contracts covering several properties also reduce costs for care home operators. The constant review and optimisation of the Cureus system care home standard guarantees the construction of care homes that truly meet demand.
