Construction is underway on the site at Artur-Becker-Straße 6 in 16816 Neuruppin, where Cureus is serving as general contractor.

The new senior residence will create more than 80 new and secure, full- and part-time jobs in Neuruppin. Employees are now being recruited for residence's inauguration. Vacancies primarily include nursing specialists and nursing assistants, as well as care and service staff.
